3.	M.Sc Pharmaceutical Chemistry	2 Years	30	45000	Candidate must have passed B.Sc. with Chemistry as major subject from any recognized University or AICTE recognized Institute/College with minimum aggregate marks of 45% or CGPA of 5.0 for Gen/OBC and 40% marks or CGPA of 4.5 for SC/ST Category.
4.	M.Sc Forensic Science	2 Years	18	45000	Candidate must have passed B.Sc. with Chemistry as major subject from any recognized University or AICTE recognized Institute/College with minimum aggregate marks of 45% or CGPA of 5.0 for Gen/OBC and 40% marks or CGPA of 4.5 for SC/ST Category.
5.	B.Sc (H) Chemistry	3Years	30	45000	Candidates have Passed in 10+2 Examination/ Equivalent Examination with at least 50% marks in aggregate in 5 subjects out of which 3 subjects English, Physics & Chemistry are mandatory.
